By His Excellency John Clarke Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Army and Navy of this State, and
of the Militia thereof.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the several acts of the General Assembly of this state, passed the 15th day of December 1818, and the 16th day of December 1819, for making distribution of the land lately acquired of the Creek and Cherokee Nations of Indians, and forming the Counties of Early, Irwin, Appling, Walton, Gwinnett, Hall, Habersham and Rabun, in this State, I HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents in the name and behalf of this State, DO GIVE AND GRANT unto Micajah

heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or lot of land containing ~~One hundred~~ ~~Acres unenclosed~~ ~~ninety seven and one~~ acres, situate, lying and being in the ~~Fifth~~ district ~~Widburn~~ county in the said State, which said tract or lot of land is known and distinguished in the plan of said district by the Number ~~fourteen~~ having such shape, form and marks as appear by a plat of the same herewise annexed; ~~To~~ HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or lot of land, together with all and singular rights, members and appurtenances thereto, whatsoever, unto the said ~~Micajah~~

Pennell and ~~his~~ heirs and assigns, to ~~his~~
and ~~their~~ own proper use, benefit and behoof forever in fee simple.



Georgia This instrument made this the 6th day of
Jackson County December one thousand eight hundred
and twenty two Between Micajah Bennett of the State
of Georgia of the one part and Joseph Williams of the State
South Carolina & Pendleton District of the other part
Witnesseth That the said Micajah Bennett for an in-
consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him
in law paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
and himself firmly satisfied hath granted bargained
and sold unto the said Joseph Williams a certain
tract or parcel of Land lying and being in Rabun County
on Tucka River it being a Lot drawn by him the
said Micajah Bennett in the last Land Lottery of the said
State and granted to him P. Bennett the fourth day of
December one thousand eight hundred and twenty two which
Land is known and distinguished in the plan of the Lottery
by the number fourteenth and fifth district in Rabun
County and still aforesaid beginning on a pond said pond
being more 67. 50 ft. a Chestnut post thence
West 70 to a pine corner thence South 80. 50 to a
cedar post on said river thence down said river to
a point containing 197 acres more or less and is the
same for my self only heirs and assigns wherein
