

A Memorial to be Registered of an Assignment of
 Judgment in the words and figures following that is
 to say 1 " Know All men by these presents that
 I William McMahon of the Village of Colham
 in the County of Ontario Esquire of the
 first part in Consideration of the Sum of
 one hundred and twenty four pounds
 three shillings and two pence of lawful
 Money of Canada to me in hand paid by
 Francis McCabe of the Township of Uxas in the
 County of Victoria Esquire of the second
 part the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 I the said party of the first part do hereby
 grant sell and assign to the said party
 of the second part a certain Judgment
 obtained by me as plaintiff against
 Patrick McCabe heir at Law of Patrick
 McCabe deceased and entered in her
 Majesty's Court of Queen's Bench for Upper
 Canada according to Law, which said
 Judgment is for the Sum of one hundred
 and five pounds for debt and thirty one
 pounds eighteen shillings and five
 pence costs, two pounds eleven shillings
 and nine pence for writs, and nine
 pounds seventeen shillings and six
 pence for Sheriff fees, and Interest
 in £136-18-5 from the 23rd day of
 July 1855 and I do hereby give
 My said assignee full power to collect
 and discharge or dispose of the same
