of fifty Shillings for every hundred acres of land hereby given
& paid into ~~the~~ treasury by Adam Gann have given and
granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the
said Adam Gann a tract of land containing one hundred
acres lying and being in the County of Washington

beginning at the end of the second line of Richard Hays
survey of ~~one~~ hundred and fifty acres on Scotch Truck
River and running thence South Forty five degrees East
Seven poles to a corner of Cypress Brooks land
East fifty five poles as aforesaid North twenty seven poles
as aforesaid East twenty three poles with a tract of James
Garners land South one hundred and forty poles to a line
of Joseph Browns land West fifty eight poles as aforesaid
South thirty six poles South fifty nine degrees West sixty
poles to a locust on the Bank of Mohan Truckey River
North two hundred and sixteen poles with J. Humphrey
lands to the Beginning as by the plat herunto
inclosed doth appear together with all woods waters minerals
hereditaments and appertinances to the J. land
belonging or appertaining To Hold to the J. Adam
Garnr his heirs and assigns forever yielding and paying
to us such Sums of money yearly or otherwise as our general
assembly from time to time may direct provided always
that the J. Adam Garnr shall cause this grant
to be Registered in the Registers office of aforesaid J. Court
of Washington within ^{twelve} months from the date hereof other
wise the same shall be void and of no effect In Testimo
ny whereof we have caused these our letters to be signed with
our great seal to be herunto affixed Witness Samuel
Johnston Esq. our our Governor Captain General and Com
mander in Chief at Edenton the Eighteenth Day of May
