& Elizabeth Hanson each an equal share in one Horse Barded

and in likewise four cows Mark Two Cows and Two Hts & a hill in lyt
anich in the right

You in whose hands Custody, Possession or keeping soever the same
are in or can or may be found to have and to hold all and

Singular the said Effects whatsoever of me the Said William

Boid unto the Said John Boid Hugh Boid Bridget Hanson

& Elizabeth Hanson their Executors Administrators and Assigns

from henceforth to their own proper use and uses to do order

and Disposse at their own Will and Pleasure as of their

own proper Goods and Chattels free peaceably and Quietly
without any manner of Interruption by me the Said William

Boid or any other person whatsoever all of which premises

the Said William Boid have put the Said above mentioned

Persons in full and peaceable possession by Virtue whereof

as also by the gift and Delivery of the same to each

other part of all the rest of the premises in Mtness whereof

the Said Boid have Received At my hand and Seal
