of me John Hill of No: 25 Gaistic street Newgate in the City of London in
the County of Middlesex all my just debts funeral and testamentary ex-
penses to be fully paid and satisfied & give and bequeath unto my geo-
neral william hill my gold watch & my silver watch together with my
relics and books and also the residue of my remaining apparel & effects and
and bequeath to my sister Mrs Anna Hill my gold watch (in possession
of Liverpool) with the gold chain which belongs to her to have
and to let her have the sum of one hundred and twenty pounds to be paid to her
son Peter Hillerell Oliver child of Anna Hill the sum of ten pounds last

paid to her within the month after my death to and for her to have and
 benefit out her receipt alone notwithstanding her marriage to her a sufficient
 discharge to my creditors then and there given and bequeathed unto
 my mother Elizabeth still the sole of my money in her executors bank
 portuguee thatt present square and also the value of my money in
 the union clear stocke alonge with together all interest due thereon es-
 pecially and also all and certein debts due and owing to me at
 the time of my decease & also give and bequeath unto my said mo-
 ther all my household furniture plate linen glass books prints and pur-
 chases and all other my estate and effects whatsoever and whatsoever
 to and for her own sole absolute use and benefit and of her my credit
 and executors executors money to collect and get in all and every her
 debt and debts due and owing to me and as and whatsoever sume shall
 be required to pay the same to my said mother & herein apponish my ex-
 quis sister Mary still and Elizabth shaines of £25 Eastie street affore
 executrix and executrix of this my will and executors executors all for-
 mire and other wills by me at any time before or since made before to
 be my last will and testament be witness executors of same at the end
 or foot thereof in my hand written letter day of 28 Febrary next year
 and signed sundays and forty seven John Hill. Signed before me
 both still the testator and for his last will and testament in the
 presence of no witness in the presence of his coxet and in the presence
 of constable George Gurrant sworne by our sevnes as witness to
 Mr Barker Elkington 31 Grayes Inn Lane. Michael Elkington. Notary
