and disposing Mind Memory and Understanding, do Make Publish and  
Declare this to be my last Will and Testament: hereby Revoking and Repealing

Eight Fourteenths of the interest of all Monies now owing to me Annually, ~~the~~  
the period of her Natural life. — I give and bequeath to Alexander Miller  
My said Seven Fourteenths of the interest of all Monies now owing to me during  
the period of his Natural life. — I give and bequeath to Margaret Miller my  
My thoughtless Sum of one hundred Dollars to be paid to her one year after  
my decease and any Profits accrued by my Executors for her sole use and benefit  
and to pay four parts of said Monies Annually to my said Alexander Miller

My natural life I give and bequeath to William Melrose  
the sum of ten shillings to be paid to her by my Executors one year after my death  
My Wife are dead: I give and bequeath to Christiana Melrose the sum of  
fifty shillings to be paid to her by my Executors one year after my death  
are dead, and she shall pay four per cent of said Money to any other Person or Persons  
Annually during her Natural life. I give and bequeath all the residue of my free  
estate to which I shall be entitled at the time of my death, to Henry Melrose and  
John Melrose, my Sons, to be paid to them by my Executors one year after my death  
my Wife are dead, and to be paid to them Share and Share alike for their living for  
Ever. And I do nominate and appoint my Wife Margaret, William Melrose  
Francis Melrose John Melrose my Sons and Robert Gerrie to be sole Executors of this my  
last Will and Testament; In Testimony whereof I the said John Melrose  
have hereunto subscribed my Name and Affixed my Seal this fifth day of  
February in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three
