parish in Spotsylvania County Our Certain Tract or parcel of Land containing four hundred acres lying and being
in the great fork of Rappahannock River in the parish and County aforesaid and bounded as followeth (to wit)
Beginning at three pines corner to Jacob Briglar and musta Eloues with the said Briglar his North
southern five degrees west two hundred poles to a Gum White Oak and Red Oak in the said Briglar his Eloues
North fifteen degrees East three hundred and twenty poles to a Gum Poplar and Spruce Eloues South seventy
five degrees East two hundred poles to a Chestnut and two White Oak on a small Run the Eloues South fifteen
degrees West three hundred and twenty poles to the Beginning **Witness** to have holden to hold
you diligence paying or provided or in witness or witness of our trusty and well beloved William Gooch Esq: our
Lieutenant & Governor and Commander in Chief of our said Colony and Dominion at Williamsburg in
the Seal of our said Colony the twenty eighth day of September one thousand seven hundred and twenty
eight in the second year of our Reigne
