Charles Lawrence 2 Grey Street Place Fiddlers  
Lane under sworn hath deposed William Still  
was 35 years of age a Law writer - Clerk & an  
Attorney - he left me at 1/2 past 3 o'clock on  
Wednesday afternoon in pursuit of Henry  
Lace - he seemed in his usual flow of  
spirit with pleasure in his manner  
had been with him about an hour - he  
said he was going to Bolton - he showed  
me a letter addressed to his wife he asked  
me if I had known the hand writing - the  
letter produced is the letter I refer to  
the hand writing of the letter is that of  
Lace - I never thought him of being intimate  
he was a man who was occasionally intimate
