is entitled to have surveyed by any legally authorized Surveyor, upon any of the vacant and unappropriated public domain of the State of Texas,

Twelve Hundred and Eighty Acres of Land
in accordance with the provisions of an act entitled

"An act granting to persons who have been permanently disabled by reason of wounds received while in the service of this State, or of the Confederate States, a land certificate for Twelve Hundred and Eighty Acres of Land," approved April 9, 1881, said R. C. Bennett having made the proofs required by said act.

A like amount of land shall be located by virtue of this Certificate for the benefit of the permanent School Fund, before either location shall be patented, and both locations shall be made upon any of the Public Domain of Texas not reserved by law from location.
