To all people unto whom these presents shall come I William
 Boid son of the County of Surry and State of North Carolina
 Greeting Know ye That to the said William Boid for Divers
 Good Causes and Valluable Considerations me hereunto moving
 have given and granted and by these presents do give grant
 and confirm unto John Boid Hugh Boid Bridget Henson
 & Elizabeth Henson ^{after their manners usage} each an equal share in one Horse Brand
 with likewise four cows Mark'd Two Cows and Two Stets Four hills in
 one in whose hands Custody, Possession or keeping were the same
 are in or can or may be found to have and to hold all and
 singular the said Effects whatsoever of me the said William
 Boid unto the said John Boid Hugh Boid Bridget Henson
 & Elizabeth Henson their Executors Administrators and Assigns
 from henceforth to their own proper use and uses to do order
 and Dispose at their own Wills and Pleasures as of their
 own proper Goods and Chattels free peaceably and Quietly
 without any manner of Interruption by me the said William
 Boid or any other person whatsoever all of which premises
 the said William Boid have put the said above mentioned
 persons in full and peaceable possession by Verdict of a Court
 as also by law gift and Delivery of the same to each
 of them on part of all the rest of the premises in Witness whereof
 the said Boid have hereunto set my hand and Seal
 this 7th of November Anno Domini 1777 ^{that in the second year}
 signed and delivered in presence of ^{of our Independence} William Boyd
