Know all men by these presents that I Amelia Eveleth of the State of Illinois and White County am held and firmly bound unto John Eveleth of the State and County aforesaid in the sum of five hundred Dollars Good and lawful money of the United States to be paid to the said John Eveleth his heirs or assigns to which Payment well and truly to be made I do bind myself heirs and assigns firmly by these presents as witness my hand and seal this 31st day of Sept. 1833

The Condition of the above bound Amelia Eveleth is such that if she her heirs or assigns shall well and truly execute a Deed of conveyance unto the said John Eveleth his heirs or assigns, upon the fulfilment of a Contract viz the said John Eveleth agrees to furnish a support for said Amelia Eveleth during life; To a certain tract of Land of the following description viz the South half of the E. 1/2 North west Quarter of Section thirteen in Township seven South of Range nine E. Containing 40 acres more or less East in the district of Lands offered for sale in Shawnee town Gallatin County Illinois Containing forty acres more or less. Then this obligation to be of no effect or else to remain in full force in law
