St. Nazianz, Wis. —(Special) — Funeral services for Cecil McCabe, 33, who passed away at the General hospital, Madison, after a lengthy illness, were held last Thursday at 1:30 p. m. at the home of his father-in-law, Adolph Wagner, in the town of Eaton, and at 2 o'clock at St. Peter's Evangelical church at Rockland. The Rev. Gerhard Schaefer officiated and burial was made in the church cemetery.
