Item I do give and bequeath unto Peter Bennett in Trust for my
daughter Sarah Hurley One negro Woman by the name of Mariah
also my Bed and Bed clothes and all the house hold and kitchen
furniture that I own or possess at my death also One half of
the debt of three hundred Dollars due me by Lane & Mansfield
But the debts that I owe for Doctors bills and my funeral
Expenses to be paid out of the One half of said debt left my said

Let my said daughter It is further my will that after the death
of my said daughter Sarah Worsley that the property willed her by me
be equally divided among her children

Now I give and bequeath unto my daughter Frances Bennett during
her life One negro girl called by the name of ~~Adina~~ also of ~~half of~~
the duty or more that I owe on ~~my~~ ~~and~~ ~~after~~ ~~the~~ ~~death~~
of my said daughter Frances I will and bequeath that the said negro girl
go to the property of Nancy Ogletree and the heirs of her body.
Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint ~~John Bennett~~ ~~executor~~ of my
my last will and testament.
