By His Excellency *John Clarke* Governor and
Commander in Chief of the Army and Navy of this State, and
of the Militia thereof.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING.

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the several acts of the General
Assembly of this state, passed the 15th day of December 1816, and the 16th day of December
1819, for making distribution of the land lately acquired of the Creek and Cherokee Nations of
Indians, and forming the Counties of Early, Irwin, Appling, Walton, Gwinnett, Hall, Haber-
sham and Habersham, in this State, I HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents
in the name and behalf of this State, DO GIVE AND GRANT unto *Micajah*

Bennett & *Boj Rogers* (Battalion *Blackson*
County *his*

heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or lot of land containing *one hundred*
twenty seven and 1/2 acres, situate, lying and being in the
5th district *Habersham* county in the said
State, which said tract or lot of land is known and distinguished in the plan of said district by
the Number *fourteen*

having such shape, form and marks as appear by a plat of the same herewith annexed; TO
HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or lot of land, together with all and singular the
rights, members and appurtenances thereof, whatsoever, unto the said *Micajah*

Bennett & *his* heirs and assigns, to *his*
and *their* own proper use, benefit and behoof forever in fee simple.

GIVEN under my hand and the Great Seal of the said State, this *fourth*
day of *December* in the year eighteen hundred and
twenty two and of the Independence of the United States of
America the *forty seventh*

Georgia within and last made this the 6th day of
Jackson County December one thousand Eight hundred
and twenty two Between Micajah Bennett of the State
of the one part and Joseph Williams of the State
South Carolina of the other part of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Micajah Bennett for an in-
consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him
in hand paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
and himself firmly satisfied hath granted bargained
and sold unto the said Joseph Williams a certain
Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in Rabun County
on Tanasa River it being a Lot reserved by him the
said Micajah Bennett in the late Land Lottery of the said
State and granted to him J. Bennett the fourth day of
December one thousand Eight hundred and twenty two which
Land is known and distinguished in the plan of S. Lottery
By the number fourteen and fifth district in Rabun
County and still aforesaid beginning on aforesaid town of
Upper Running north 67. 50 to a Chestnut post thence
East 70 to a pine corner thence South 50 to a
cypress post on said River thence down said River to
beginning containing 197 acres more or less and the
same being for my self my heirs and assigns forever
